



(Very) Tentative Itinerary

- Fly from Detroit to Berlin (via Frankfurt)
- Berlin—4 days. Sites will include the Brandenburg Gate, a trip to the German parliament building, KaDeWe department store, and a day trip to Potsdam.
- Munich—3 days. Sites will include the Marienplatz, the Pinakothek art museums, a bike tour of the city, and an optional trip to Dachau concentration camp.
- Freiberg am Neckar. This will be a 2 week homestay with a German family. Students will attend school Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday, with 2 Wednesday day trips. Weekends will be spent with the family.
- Travel by train from Freiberg am Neckar to Frankfurt am Main, depart via direct flight to Detroit.

We will be traveling to Germany in June, 2013. The trip will last approximately 3 weeks, and will include site-seeing in Berlin and Munich before traveling to our partner school in Freiberg am Neckar, north of Stuttgart, for a 2 week homestay. There will be an informational meeting for parents

and students on Wednesday, May 2nd. There will be a second meeting in September, where I will begin the official sign-up. Preference will be given to students taking German 3 and 4, and I will go from there as needed.
